TOWN-WIDE REAPPRAISAL!

Beginning May 16th, two members of the Thetford Board of Listers will be visiting all residential properties to collect and confirm data. These visits will be preceded by an "appointment letter", which will advise you of your appointment date and time. If the proposed date and time is not convenient for you, please contact us to reschedule. We plan on sending this letter to each property owner about a week before the actual visit will occur, so please watch your mail.

Common Reappraisal Myth: A commonly held myth about reappraisals is that it will increase your taxes. In fact, what really happens is that everyone's assessment goes up so the tax rate goes down (unless large budgets are voted in). Besides reallocating tax burden, reappraisals bring the town's common level of assessment closer to 100% of fair market value. The closer a town is to 100% fair market value, the lower the town's Education tax rate will be.

The Listers have contracted with the Vermont Appraisal Company to assist us with Commercial properties, Farms, and Elected Official's properties. They will also do all the Market research and build a land schedule which will be applied to all properties.

✓ Some tips on how to make your site visit easier:

1. Property Owners do <u>not</u> need to be present - they may assign an agent to let us into the buildings. The agent must be of age, cannot be a minor.

2. Please restrain all animals for their safety and ours.

The Listers office will continue to be open Tuesdays and Wednesdays (8:30AM - 4PM) and will conduct business as usual. We welcome a visit from any property owner who has questions or concerns.
