### THETFORD TRAIL'S MASTER PLAN

A study currently being conducted by Resource Systems Group and Thetford's own Morton Trails is looking at current trail routes within the Town of Thetford as well as potential routes that will form the basis for an **Inter-Village Trails Master Plan**. The Master Plan will help direct trail planning and building around and in the Villages of Thetford. Trails will be planned that provide access to residents of multiple trail-user groups, as well as produce minimal impact to the natural communities of Thetford.
