LED CHRISTMAS LIGHTING USES LESS ENERGY

According to the US Department of Energy's (DOE) Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy Office, LED holiday lights can save 70 to 90% in energy costs over traditional incandescent lights. Other advantages include a longer lifespan, cooler bulbs with a reduced risk of fire, and the ability to connect more strings without overloading the wall socket. DOE estimates that if every household switched to using LED holiday lights, the country would save approximately \$410 million in electricity costs. If both residential households and the commercial sector switched to LED holiday lights today, the savings would be equivalent to the output of almost 500,000 households.
