*Joshua Jacobs-Rebhun '14 is one of two Upper Valley students who were recently awarded the Rensselaer Medal, a merit scholarship to Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. The award is given to students who have distinguished themselves in math and science. If Josh attends RPI, he will receive a minimum of \$15,000 a year toward the cost of his education. The medal is the oldest prize of its kind in the United States and is awarded at more than 2,000 high schools in North American, Latin America, Europe, and Asia.

*Thetford Academy English teacher Joseph Deffner has been chosen as a "summer scholar" by the National Endowment for the Humanities. He recently attended a workshop on the campus of Millsaps College in Jackson, MS, titled "One Place, One Time: Jackson, Mississippi, 1963." Mr. Deffner is one of 80 teachers chosen from around the country.

THETFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: TRASH TALK

Last spring the Natural Resource Recovery Association (NRRA) visited TES for a day of education and assessment of our systems to reduce school waste. We received a score of 93% for our recycling and composting efforts and set new goals to divert even more TES waste from the landfill. For example, students are now collecting all (unbleached) paper towels used in classrooms and it's using it as carbon material for our compost system. Because paper towels make up 96% of our classroom landfill waste, this simple, school-wide strategy results in a huge reduction of trash every day. That the paper towels are repurposed as compost feedstock without burning an ounce of gas is another bonus. Our next goal is to significantly reduce the amount of printing paper used at school. Hats off to TES students, staff, families and the many community participants who work together to minimize school waste and protect the environment.
