
COMMUNITY NURSE OF THETFORD



Happy 200th Birthday, Thetford Academy!











Past graduating classes of Thetford Academy, such as those of 1888 and 1935, were significantly smaller than they are today.

TA burned down in 1942. The fire also destroyed the 1846 dormitory, the town library, and a building next door as Thetford residents and students scurried to save books and furniture. There were no fatalities. Coal in the academy's cellar smoldered for months, even as students returned to school in borrowed quarters just one week later. The school reopened across the street in 1949.



Above: Notable TA students include Mary Hosford, the first woman in the U.S. to receive a college diploma (Oberlin College, 1841), and Justin Smith Morrill, who created the legislation that established federal funding for public colleges and universities.
